



MOHE Egypt Cambridge Scholarship 2018

The Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research, in partnership with the Cambridge Trust, offers Egyptian students an opportunity to take a research degree (PhD) at the University of Cambridge in the UK.

Who can apply?

You are eligible to apply if:

- you are normally resident in Egypt
- you are currently working in a public university or research institute in Egypt, and are offered MOHE or Newton-Mosharafa full scholarship
- you apply to take a PhD (in any subject) at the University of Cambridge (to start your research there in 2018-19) and are offered admission

Application Procedure

You need to apply to both the MOHE and to the University of Cambridge:

- MOHE
 - apply to the MOHE via www.mohe-casm.edu.eg/
 - shortlisted candidates will be invited for interview
- University of Cambridge
 - check carefully the entry requirements for the course you wish to study
 - if possible, make contact with the relevant Department within the University, to find out if there is a suitable academic supervisor for your proposed thesis
 - submit an online application to the University of Cambridge via its website <https://www.graduate.study.cam.ac.uk/how-do-i-apply> before the deadline (which is either 6 December 2017 or 4 January 2018 - check which deadline applies to your chosen course)

If you are offered admission to the University, and shortlisted by MOHE, you will be invited for interview in Egypt. Final selection of scholars will be made jointly by MOHE and CCEIT, and a maximum of five scholarships will be awarded.

What will the scholarship pay?

Successful applicants will receive full funding for three years, sufficient to cover

- annual University tuition fee
- annual stipend or living allowance
- one return airfare

Scholars may be eligible for stipend for up to one year's additional 'writing up'
